

Bemidji/Cass Outing Rules

We encourage all members and non-members to participate.

This is a great way for all of us to get together and share in the sport we all love so much.

We are doing big fish pot and most points pot again this year. \$10.00 each. You do not have to do either of the pots if you don't want to, but if you do, please pay at the first outing you attend.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Attendance 1 point.

Netman 1 point.

Bring a new nonmember (one time per person) 1 point.

Fish points:

30-39.99 - 4 points

40-44.99 - 5 points

45-47.99 - 6 points

48 - 8 points

49 - 9 points

50 - 10 points

51 - 11 points

52 - 12 points

53 - 13 points

54 - 14 points

55 - 15 points

56 - 16 points

57 - 17 points

58 - 18 points

Additional rules and information:

1. MI minimum 30" applies for a fish to qualify
2. A photo MUST be taken of caught fish – this can be in the net, a release shot, or holding (preferred) If it is a big fish and possibly could win big fish we need it on a bump board.
3. You do not have to fish the entire allotted time – make sure to contact the Outing Chair to record your attendance in the days outing and to report caught fish size/angler/netman.
4. If fishing alone and a muskie is boated – the netman point does not apply
5. Size points will be awarded in ½ inch increments. A 48.5in fish will be 8.5pts. Remember we use the honor system for measurement. Any in between measurements will be rounded down to nearest 1/2 inch increment.
6. Muskie hunter of the year is awarded to the person with most points over the course of this years outings.
7. In the event of a tie there can be a gentleman's/ gentlewomans agreement. If no agreement is reached we will have co-champions.
